

Questionnaire to identify teamwork-related resources and stressors in firefighting operations (REST-Q Fire)

In the following, various situations from firefighting operations are described.

We are interested in **how often** you have experienced such or similar situations in a firefighting operation. Please refer to operations of the fire department in which you **mainly** work. Consider all operations, **regardless of the function** in which you were deployed.

Please try to put yourself in the situations described and think back to various firefighting operations you have experienced in your career that are similar to the situation described.

In firefighting operations, **teamwork** carries a high value - we want to know which behaviors in the team are perceived as **particularly stressful**, but also as **particularly supportive**.

Accordingly, two options are described for each situation described and we ask you to evaluate both.

On the one hand, we describe which **negative behaviors** could occur and want to know how much such things stress you out.

On the other hand, we describe situations in which **positive behaviors** were exhibited and want to know how much something like that helps you during firefighting operations.

In part, the situation descriptions sound very similar. This is because different negative and positive behaviors can occur in very similar situations and we want to capture a comprehensive picture. That is why we ask you to answer **all** the questions anyway.

Now please read the following situation descriptions. Put yourself in your previous experienced firefighting operations that are similar to the situation described and then answer the questions formulated for this purpose.
